PFLAG Cape Cod is offering a \$3,000 Anne Toran Scholarship to a graduating high school senior who has demonstrated support and advocacy for the LGBTQ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer or Questioning) community. **The award will be based on evidence of such involvement and effort.**

In order to be eligible, you must complete the application, write an essay, and secure two recommendations — one from your guidance counselor and another from an adult who is familiar with your efforts on behalf of the LGBTQ community. The Application, Release Form (bottom of this page), and essay must be submitted to your Guidance Department by Friday, March 29, 2019 (Application forms are also available at www.pflagcapecod.org).

The recipient and relevant Guidance Department will be notified by May 3, 2019. Payment will be made to the student after successful completion of their first semester. Also, we hope to recognize the school recipient at one of our May PFLAG meetings.

All information submitted by candidates is confidential, but we ask candidates to sign a release of information allowing PFLAG to publicize the scholarship program by announcing the recipient in local newspapers. We hope you will allow this privilege, but your denial of permission to release information will not affect consideration of your application.
